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English Language Test Preparation

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Introduction

For students, taking a high-stakes English language test can be a stressful experience. Fortunately, there are myriad resources available for today's test takers and for teachers who are guiding the preparation journey. We spoke with test makers to dig into best practices and strategies for language test preparation, and we identified some of the best resources available to test takers and teachers of test takers. As an English language teacher, resources that are effective and accessible are invaluable. Because tests are now often delivered online, preparation strategies have changed in many ways. While language proficiency may be universal, test format and delivery may differ, making preparation strategies for individual tests differ, as well. In a series of interviews with testing company representatives, we found the most important test preparation strategies included familiarization with the practice test, harnessing the expertise of teachers, and immersing oneself in the English language through a variety of resources.

As many of today's tests are delivered remotely, knowing the details of the student's specific test is incredibly important, as content delivery may differ from test to test. Teachers who are well versed in the details of the specific test can guide preparation by identifying strengths and weaknesses, preparing students for specific content and response delivery methods, and more. Apps, videos, podcasts, and other resources are available for both test takers and the teachers who prepare them for exam day. Some resources are free to both students and teachers, while others require registration or purchase.

Avant Assessment offers a variety of English language tests, including STAMP, STAMP Pro, and Avant Placement.

• The STAMP test is for Grades 2–6, Grades 7–Higher Education, and Adults. The test assesses reading, writing, listening, and speaking. It's offered in English and 17 other languages.

STAMP Pro assesses reading, writing, listening, and speaking, or it can be broken down into different combinations of skills for a shorter testing experience.
This test is available in English and 16 other languages.
Avant Place is a language placement test in reading, contextualized grammar, writing, and speaking. This is used to assess language course placement.

While there are a variety of new ways to prepare for language tests, the basic tenets remain the same: Familiarize yourself with the test and focus on language proficiency. There are no effective test hacks or shortcuts. While taking practice tests may be an old method, it's still important today. What's changed is the addition of ensuring familiarity with digital format additions.

"I think part of it is understanding how the testing system works," said Higher Education Specialist Nick Gossett. He added that reviewing a sample test is important. "What does it look like? What should you expect?" **Duolingo's English Test** is accepted by 3,500 universities, can be completed online from anywhere, and provides results within 48 hours. The test is adaptive and assesses reading, writing, speaking, and listening. On the Duolingo website, test takers can access a free practice test, review question types, and download the official test guide. For students and teachers of English language students, Content Marketing Manager Caroline Fisher said the Test Readiness Guide is one of the best resources.

"In the guide, there's also a breakdown of each question type and tips," she added. Some are user based, so they'll ask things like 'Can I go back and submit my answer again?' and 'What happens when the time runs out?' I do think it's the best resource and the most comprehensive one we have.

All Duolingo test preparation materials are free. "Another part of our philosophy is that we want it to be aligned to our mission, 'Accessible to all,'" Fisher said. "That's why all test readiness content is free, all available on our website. Go there or to our FAQs. You can also chat with our support team. You don't have to have taken the test."

English3 offers the English3 Interview for J-1 Exchange visitors and E3PT for university admissions. English3 is in the process of transitioning to the GATEWAY test and phasing out the E3PT. The English3 test assesses speaking, listening, reading, and writing. English3 offers the practice exam, tutoring services, and preparation courses that include tutor sessions, 10 practice interviews, and unlimited online practice. For students who take the exam and do not receive a passing score, there are options for one-on-one feedback and English Complete or English Plus courses.

"When you make the move from print to digital, your whole framework has to change," CEO Moroni Flake said. "For us, how we test is valid in as much as it assesses what it assesses, how well it aligns with the experience, with what students are expected to do. When you make the move to online, you now have a digital experience where you are trying to transfer to the space rather than the assessment."

"We put students in scenarios, then [they] respond," he said. "Like, they may see a teacher in a classroom and respond or respond in a classroom discussion. So, how does that flow into test prep? Prepare for the same experiences that you would need for an academic experience." **Password** offers a variety of tests, which include Password Skills (reading, writing, listening, and speaking), Password Skills Receptive (reading and listening), Password Knowledge (grammar and vocabulary), Password Knowledge and Writing (grammar, vocabulary, and writing), Password Pupil English (grammar, vocabulary, and writing), Password Pupil English Younger (grammar, vocabulary, and writing), Password Workforce (a choice of grammar, vocabulary, writing, and speaking), and Bespoke tests (Password test modules that may be used in combination with and/or in conjunction with in-house tests).

Depending on the test, these assessments are used for a variety of purposes, such as admission to undergraduate, postgraduate, and pre-university programs, admission to English language courses, assessment of new students, admission to independent and international schools, and for employment purposes.

"Mid- to high-stakes test preparation hasn't changed that much when it comes to the actual language skills that are being tested, but it has added certain components that would not be applicable to paper-based tests," Head of University Partnerships Shelley Vink said. "Students who are preparing for a test that is delivered online require a certain amount of digital literacy, and preparation for an at-home, online test requires a test taker to understand technical requirements, as well as the required English language skills."

ETS offers the TOEFL tests and the TOEIC tests. TOEIC tests prove English communication skills for business English. TOEFL iBT and TOEFL Essentials tests measure the four core language skills for university admissions. TOEFL iBT can be taken online at home, online in a testing center, or in a paper-based format in a testing center. Preparation materials for all delivery formats are available, with some options free and some through a paid purchase.

Because there are so many options for test delivery these days and students have varying needs, Director of TOEFL Learning and Support Jazzme Blackwell said, "We provide different test prep [resources] to meet the needs of the students."

"For the paper-delivered test, we offer a practice test that is in the format of the paper delivered test as they would experience it on the day of the test," said Blackwell. "Practice materials for the TOEFL iBT are also the same as they would experience. We offer TPO practice online that would simulate the experience the test taker would have."

The TOEFL practice online test is also available in different variations, depending on what students would like to focus on – speaking only, reading and listening, or speaking and writing. The TPO practice online test must be purchased, and students receive scores.

Skills for English offers the SELT exam, which is the UK Home Office approved SELT for UK visa applications for work, study, and settlement, as well as the Skills for English Global exam for international student direct entry, career improvement, and school testing. The SELT exam is delivered in testing centers, whereas the Skills for English (Global) test has always been a computer-based test that may be taken from home, so preparation materials reflect the formats of the tests. There are practice tests available for both exams, located on the Skills for English website, with resources to help candidates identify their proficiency level, understand the test, improve their knowledge, and practice the test. Skills for English Recognitions Specialist, US and Canada, Tracy Springer points out that using the Skills for English digital preparation resources will mirror "what will be presented to [test takers] on test day since the format will be familiar to them. It will help them be more comfortable when they take the test and, hopefully, [they will] have a better testing experience."

Along with a variety of test preparation materials available on the Skills for English website, Springer also suggests students create an account with the SQA Academy, which is the organization that developed the Skills for English Test. Account access will provide opportunities to further develop and improve language skills, as the academy offers additional grammar and vocabulary practice for test takers.

Michigan Language Assessment offers tests for young learners, teens, and adults at all levels of English proficiency. The MYLE test is a set of American English exams for beginning learners ages 6 to 10, the MET Go! Is a multilevel exam for upper primary to lower secondary school students, the MET is a flexible, multilevel exam for learners ages 16 to adult for educational and professional purposes, the ECCE is a four-skill certificate exam for secondary students and adults at the high-intermediate level, the ECPE is a four-skill exam certifying secondary students and adults at the highest level of proficiency, and the Michigan English Placement test is a computerbased placement and progress test used by institutions and businesses for internal purposes.

The Michigan English Test (MET), the Examination for the Certificate of Competency in English (ECCE), and the Examination for the Certificate of Proficiency in English (ECPE) are high-stakes tests that are accepted as proof of English proficiency for university admissions, employment, immigration, and professional licensure purposes. The ECCE and ECPE are paper-based tests administered at Authorized Test Centers. The MET is digitally delivered at test centers and remotely from home. "Michigan Language Assessment is a notfor-profit collaboration between Cambridge University Press and Assessment and the University of Michigan," Director of Marketing, Communications, and Stakeholder Relations Fernando Fleurquin said. "Our CEO, Sharon Harvey, reports to a Board of Directors with members from both organizations. Michigan Language Assessment's Assessment and Operations Department is responsible for the development, production, administration, and scoring of our tests. Considering the close relationships we have with our parent organizations, we collaborate with them in many areas."

"The Michigan English Test was recently recognized by the U.S. Health Resources and Services Administration office and CGFNS International to apply for occupational visas in the healthcare sector to work in the U.S."






Student Test Preparation Courses and Resources
