Online Language Company Freelancer

This is a great starting point for teachers who are new to independently teaching English online. Students may range from children to adults, and courses may be 1:1 or small groups. Language companies handle all payment transactions and provide course curriculum. They also typically provide access to continued professional development or "CPD." Some examples of online language schools include **BridgeEnglish**, EF Teach Online, and Lingoda.



Marketplace Tutor

This is a "sweet spot" between freelancing and being a fully independent teacherpreneur. Marketplaces still provide technical support, including all payment transactions, but you'll set your rates and develop your courses. Marketplace tutors create profiles showcasing their services to students who register with the marketplace. You can tutor children or adults, 1:1 or in small groups. You can offer a variety of courses. Marketplaces are free to use but charge a commission. Some examples of marketplaces include Langu, Preply, and Cambly.



Independent Teacherpreneur

Teacherpreneurs are fully independent teachers who set up a website or subscribe to an eLearning platform to host their courses. As a teacherpreneur, you'll develop your own brand and market your services on your site, on social media, and on other channels, develop custom courses, handle all client interactions, and take care of all accounting. You choose your course offerings and rates.

Begin the Application Process

An online language company will first look at an applicant's resume, focusing on teaching experience and TEFL certification and any additional education or certifications.

After checking qualifications, an interview will be scheduled. The purpose of the interview will not only be to discuss qualifications, but for the interviewer to observe your body language, how you speak, and how you present yourself.

Components of an interview may include:

- ⊗ a teaching demo
- questions about your teaching background conducting a trial class
- 𝔅 questions to engage your adaptability
- 𝔅 questions about your teaching philosophy

To prepare for the interview, you'll want to:

- Conduct research on the company.
 Practice speaking with confidence.
 Test your technology ahead of time.
 Dress professionally.
- Set your computer up and analyze the lighting and background.
- © Check the interview time, taking into consideration time zone differences.

Set Up an Eye-Catching Profile

A good profile is engaging, professional, and personal. Each tutor in a marketplace sets their own schedule and rates, as will you. Marketplaces are made up of teacher profiles, so you'll be competing for students with other professionals. To make a profile that stands out, you'll want to:

- ⊗ Include a good profile picture.
- ♂ Write a strong bio.
- Summarize your qualifications and experience.
- ♂ Highlight your specializations and teaching niche.
- ♂ Include a self-introduction video.
- Include your resume.
- S Mention other relevant services you offer.
- ♂ Include student reviews.
- ♂ Include your contact information.

Remember, a profile is the first impression students will have of you, so be sure everything included is carefully curated to make the best first impression.
